Comes now Complainant/Reporting Officer **Crystal Kent** And states the following under oath:

I have probable cause to believe the defendant committed the crime of:

565.090-003Y201753 Harassment - 1st Degree (F): STAT  
566.151-998Y200236 Enticement Of A Child (actor 21 Years Of Age Or Older And Child Less Than 15 Years Of Age) (F): STAT

At or about **08:07:00 PM** on or about the date of **08/31/2018**

At **1 Hornet Dr, Fulton - Fulton High School In Callaway County, Missouri**

The facts which support a finding of probable cause to believe that a crime or crimes were committed and that the above person committed that / those offense (s) are:

On 08/31/2018 at approximately 2007 hours the Fulton Police Department received a report of a sexual assault reported by [REDACTED] 15-year old female, and her grandparents. [REDACTED] explained Teneil Stevenson, 35 year old male, a was her PE coach and Track coach the year prior but left to coach at Southern Boone County now. [REDACTED] told me Stevenson friend requested her on Snapchat after a track meet last year and she accepted. [REDACTED] told me Stevenson would first just message her stating she did well at the track meet or what not, but that was all. [REDACTED] stated Stevenson sent her a photo of himself from his camera roll. [REDACTED] stated in the photo Stevenson was of himself fully clothed and appeared someone else had taken the photo. The photo looked like it was in the hallway at the middle school and Stevenson circled his private parts. In the message sent with the photo Stevenson said why would they take this picture of me it shows my magic stick?"

[REDACTED] told me later in the summer while she was at a friends house, Stevenson began sending her messages again. Stevenson sent [REDACTED] messages stating things he wanted to do to her, which she described as Stevenson saying "I'm going to crush your body" and "I am going to touch you like no other guy could." [REDACTED] told me she did not respond back to Stevenson, and he responded with "oh that's how it is?" [REDACTED] told me she began crying and her friend, [REDACTED] was present when this occurred. After speaking with [REDACTED] she confirmed [REDACTED] received messages from Stevenson in reference to what he wanted to do to her. [REDACTED] also told me [REDACTED] became afraid of Stevenson and what could happen if she told anyone. [REDACTED] told me Stevenson stopped messaging her for a short time, and then began swiping up (reacting to pictures [REDACTED] posted on her story) and making comments or sending emoji's in reaction to her pictures.

[REDACTED] explained on 08/31/2018 she received a message from Stevenson telling her good luck at the game and he hoped to see her there. [REDACTED] is a [REDACTED] the Fulton High School and on 08/31/2018 Fulton High School played Southern Boone in a Football game at Fulton.

The facts which support a finding that the defendant either will not appear on a summons or poses a danger to the victim of the offense, the community or any other person are:

Stevenson is a teacher, who no longer works for Fulton however he is employed with Southern Boone County School District as a football coach.
